Lagoon is an amusement park in Farmington, Utah, located seventeen miles north of Salt Lake City. It has been privately owned since it opened in 1886. Lagoon offers rides, entertainment, food and fun for all ages.

- Lagoon has ten roller coasters, four of which are unique to Lagoon:
 - Cannibal, which opens in 2015 will be the tallest, most exciting coaster on the park. This state of the art coaster will thrill riders with its unique elements unlike anything else in the country.
 - Colossus the Fire Dragon is the only Schwarzkopf Double Looping coaster still in operation.
 - Wicked launches riders to the top of a 110 foot tower at speeds close to 41 mph then passes through steep valleys, high bank turns, a half-pipe, heart-roll inversion and more.
 - Bombora is a fun coaster the entire family can enjoy.
- Lagoon A Beach waterpark, located in the center of the park, has 550,000 gallons of water fun with something for everyone:
 - Three serpentine slides that drop riders from a 56 foot tower and send them twisting and splashing to the bottom.
 - Two drop slides which produce the sensation of falling straight down until riders glide smoothly to the splash pools below.
 - A Lazy River surrounded by crystal waterfalls, exotic tunnels and tropical lagoons.
 - Two activity pools for water lovers of all ages and several sun decks and lounge chairs for soaking up the sun.
- Pioneer Village – a reconstruction of a typical frontier community as it might have existed in the late 1800's transports guests 100 years back in time.
 - Consists of 42 buildings and the artifacts with which they may have once been furnished.
 - Features one of the finest collections of small arms in the country, including guns, sling shots, crossbows and cannons.
 - The Carriage Hall features almost every type of wheeled conveyance used at the turn of the century.
- Frightmares – Lagoon transforms into a frightfully fun adventure during September and October featuring 7 haunted attractions, Halloween inspired decorations and entertainment.
 - Spook-A-Boo and Scary & Crow's Straw Maze are fun, non-scary walk-thrus for children inhabited by friendly characters.



- Nightwalk, Zombie Lockdown and Twisted Tales are meant for those who enjoy a scare and are not for the faint of heart. Offering scary scenes and characters.
- Fun House of Fear and the Pioneer Village Scare Zone offer scares and chills for children and adults.
- Character Dining – for an additional fee, families can dine with the Frightmares Characters such as Hackenslash Chainsaw Team, Dracula, Pirates, and possibly Frankenstein or a witch.
- Lagoon’s R.V. Park and Campground is located adjacent to Lagoon. Our grassy, shaded campground is a short walk from the main entrance.
