

# The Lagoon Look

Hair shall be clean, combed, and neatly trimmed. Unnatural colors and extreme styles are not permitted. Sideburns, moustaches, and beards should be neatly trimmed. Eccentric styles of facial hair are not permitted.

No extreme or distracting makeup.

Employees with extreme or offensive tattoos may be asked, and must agree, to cover tattoos while on duty. Perfume, cologne, or after shave should be used sparingly.

Uniform shirts shall be tucked in at all times, on or off duty. T-shirts worn under uniform shirts shall be plain (with no logos) and light colored.

Pants/Shorts should be "trouser" or "slack" in style and light brown or tan in color (unless otherwise specified by your department). Cargo pockets, frayed hems, extreme flairs, tears, holes, corduroy, jean/denim fabric, or "skinny" style are not acceptable. Belts should be worn and be black or brown with a conservative buckle.

Shoes should be a solid color. NO extreme or bright colored shoes or shoelaces are permitted.

Socks must be worn and should be light in color.

Food Service Employees must wear full-length pants and a Lagoon issued hat and apron. Aprons must be tied in the back at all times.



Jewelry may be worn if it is in good taste and will not interfere with your job duties or safety. Exposed piercings or gauges are not allowed, with the exception of a simple pair of earrings. No extreme or distracting make-up.

ID Cards must be worn and visible while working, using an approved clip or Lagoon issued breakaway lanyard. While not in uniform, employees may not wear their ID Badge.

Landscaping Employees must wear navy blue pants or shorts. Gloves will be issued, and should be used as needed.

Pants/Shorts should be worn at the hip. NO "low rider" or "low rise" styles are permitted.

Shorts should be no shorter than the fingertips and no longer than the knees.

Shoes should be comfortable with a low sole. Open toed shoes are not permitted.

Jackets, sweatshirts, hats, or other optional items must be Lagoon approved. Hats must be worn with the brim facing forward.

Grounds Employees must wear full-length black pants.

Lifeguards must wear sandals, Lagoon issued uniform t-shirt, swim shorts, whistle, and visor or hat.



In addition to these basic guidelines, your department or position may have some other uniform requirements. Please check your department manual for specific information. Employees who report to work in unacceptable attire may be requested to leave work and return in acceptable attire without pay. Repeated abuse of the uniform policy may result in disciplinary action.
