LAGOON PARK UPDATE

June 13, 2020

Beginning June 15, 2020, all guests with the exception of very young children and toddlers will be required to wear a face covering (mask) within all ride queues. This is in addition to maintaining appropriate social distance as indicated by marks placed on the ground and signs posted. Guests are required to have a face covering (mask) in order to enter the Park.

IMPORTANT! PLEASE NOTE: To maintain social distancing, avoid crowding at the Park entrance, and achieve capacity limitations, an online reservation system has been implemented. Guests purchasing a Single Day Passport and our season passholders will be required to make a reservation online for Park admission. Tickets may be purchased online at the same time the reservation is made. This will speed and simplify the process of entering and obtaining a wristband that will be used to confirm authorization for Park privileges. Reservations are available now online for one week out.
