#### **LAGOON PARK UPDATE**

**SEPTEMBER 10, 2020**

All guests, with the exception of very young children and toddlers, will be required to wear a face covering (mask) within all ride queues and ride lines. This is in addition to maintaining appropriate social distance as indicated by marks placed on the ground and signs posted. Guests will also be required to wear a face mask inside all haunted attractions during Frightmares.

To maintain social distancing, avoid crowding at the Park entrance, and achieve capacity limitations, an online reservation system has been implemented. However, Lagoon's loyal season passport holders and guests purchasing a Season or Single Day Passport online will not be required to make a reservation for Park admission. Your reservation will be automatically recorded as you enter the Park. All guests waiting to enter are subject to our authorized capacity limitations. We expect delays, if any, will be minimal.

This policy may be re-evaluated during Frightmares to determine if reservations will be needed.

All other Passport Holders must still make a reservation. This will speed and simplify the process of entering and obtaining a wristband that will be used to confirm authorization for Park privileges. Reservations are available now online for one week out. For your protection, the following cleaning procedures have been put in place for Frightmares:

- Sanitize all haunted attractions prior to daily opening
- High touch surfaces sanitized regularly
- Social distancing in lines and throughout haunted attraction is required
- Most actors in the haunted attractions will wear masks and gloves
